ELIGIBILITY FOR DISTRICT XI LACROSSE TOURNAMENT:

- League champions will automatically qualify for the District XI Lacrosse playoffs and be granted preferential seeding.
- Any additional team which has won 50% or more of its league games or 50% or more of its total scheduled games will also be eligible. *Only games scheduled prior to the beginning of the lacrosse season will be considered.*

<u>CUT-OFF DATE FOR ENTRIES:</u> Games played and completed by the end of the day on **Monday, May 15, 2017** will be counted toward entrance into the District XI Lacrosse Tournament.

There WILL NOT be a seeding meeting. Seeding will be automatically calculated by the District XI Power Rating System which is based on the results of all games that a team plays.

METHOD OF SEEDING:

- To be recognized, a league must include at least five (5) District XI teams.
- League champions will be seeded first per District XI Preferential Seeding policy. Sub-regionals will not have preferential seeding in any sport or class.
- If a tournament does not have eight (8) eligible teams, the top seeded team(s) will receive a bye in the quarter-final round of play.

• "AT LARGE" teams, who do not belong to a District XI lacrosse league, must also win at least 50% of the games in the league in which they compete or 50% of a minimum of ten (10) scheduled games to be eligible for the tournament.

<u>GAME LOCATIONS:</u> Quarter-final games will be played at the home field of the top-seeded teams. The top-seeded team is responsible for managing the game as if it were a regular season game. Should the District XI Committee determine the home field inadequate, an alternative site in the home team's area will be selected. District XI will not be responsible for any fees paid for use of the field.

FINANCES: Reimbursement and expenses will be paid in accordance with District XI Policy.

ASSIGNMENT OF OFFICIALS: Officials are assigned by the District XI Officials Representative.

SPORTSMANSHIP STATEMENT: PIAA requires all registered sports' officials to enforce the sportsmanship rules for coaches and contestants. Actions meant to demean opposing contestants, teams, spectators and officials are not in the highest ideals of interscholastic education and will not be tolerated. Let all contests reflect mutual respect. Coaches will certify prior to the contest that teams are legally equipped according to the rules of that contest.

ATHLETIC TRAINER

• Each team is requested to supply an athletic trainer for its respective athletes.

GAME BALLS: The home team shall provide six (6) game balls for the Quarterfinal round game. District XI will provide game balls for the Semifinal and Championship games.
