**ELIGIBILITY FOR DISTRICT XI LACROSSE TOURNAMENT:**

- District XI league champions will automatically qualify for the lacrosse championship tournaments. To be recognized, a league must include at least five (5) District XI teams.
- Any additional team which has won 50% or more of its league games or 50% or more of its total scheduled games will also be eligible. ***Only games scheduled prior to the beginning of the lacrosse season will be considered.***

<b>All interested teams must complete their District XI Power Rating information no later than 3:00pm on Tuesday, May 15, 2018. See information in front of handbook.</b>

**METHOD OF SEEDING:**

- All games completed by the end of play on Monday, May 15<sup>th</sup> will be counted.
- District XI Power Rating will be used in sub-regional championships. Only self-contained championships will utilize preferential seeding, with league champions seeded first per District XI Preferential Seeding policy.
- “AT LARGE” teams, who do not belong to a District XI lacrosse league, must also win at least 50% of the games in the league in which they compete or 50% of a minimum of ten (10) scheduled games to be eligible for the tournament.
- Incomplete brackets will be filled using the District XI Power Point System.
- If a tie occurs for a position in the bracket, the following criteria shall be used to break the tie:
  1. Head-to-head competition.
  2. Total goals scored against each other.
  3. Flip of a coin. The winner of the toss will win the seed
  4. Re-seeding WILL NOT occur after any round of the playoffs.

**GAME LOCATIONS:** Quarter-final games will be played at the home field of the top-seeded teams. The top-seeded team is responsible for managing the game as if it were a regular season game. Should the District XI Committee determine the home field inadequate, an alternative site in the home team’s area will be selected. District XI will not be responsible for any fees paid for use of the field.

**FINANCES:** Reimbursement and expenses will be paid in accordance with District XI Policy.

**ASSIGNMENT OF OFFICIALS:** Officials are assigned by the District XI Officials Representative.

**SPORTSMANSHIP STATEMENT:** PIAA requires all registered sports' officials to enforce the sportsmanship rules for coaches and contestants. Actions meant to demean opposing contestants, teams, spectators and officials are not in the highest ideals of interscholastic education and will not be tolerated. Let all contests reflect mutual respect. Coaches will certify prior to the contest that teams are legally equipped according to the rules of that contest.

**ATHLETIC TRAINER**

- Each team is requested to supply an athletic trainer for its respective athletes.

**GAME BALLS:** The home team shall provide twelve (12) game balls for the Quarter-final round game. District XI will provide game balls for the Semi-final and Championship games.
