WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE:

- A. District XI league champion will automatically qualify for District XI Playoffs and will be seeded before the other teams in their respective classifications. To be recognized, a league must include at least five District XI teams.
- B. Teams that have won 50% or more of their league games or 50% or more of their total scheduled games, regardless of ranking, will also be eligible.
- C. Teams must have played 10 contests to qualify.
- D. Cut-off date for entries: ***Thursday, May 14th, 2019 at 11:59pm***
- E. Qualifiers determined by District XI Policy on qualifications as seen in handbook:
 1A- 4 2A-4 *3A-4 4A-6 5A-4 6A-8
 *3A is Sub-Reg with District 1 (New Hope)

METHOD OF SEEDING

- **District XI Power Rating System**
- League Champions will be seeded first

TIEBREAKER: The District XI Power Rating System tiebreaking procedure will be used to break seeding ties.

ASSIGNMENT OF OFFICIALS: The Male Officials Representative will assign in conjunction with PIAA Baseball Assignors in District XI.

SPORTSMANSHIP STATEMENT: PIAA requires registered sports’ officials to enforce the sportsmanship Rules for coaches and contests. Actions meant to demean opposing contestants, teams, spectators, and officials are not I the highest ideals of interscholastic education will not be tolerated.
