DISTRICT COMMITTEE PERSON IN CHARGE OF TOURNAMENT

- A. Any school that chooses to not compete in the District XI Softball Tournament should inform the Softball Chairperson by 4pm on Monday, May 8, 2023.
- B. Only games scheduled prior to the beginning of the softball season will be considered.
- C. All games complete by 9:00 p.m. on May 19, 2023, will be counted toward entrance into the District XI Softball Tournament.

METHOD OF SEEDING:

The procedure of seeding teams will be as follows:

- A. Only games completed on or before May 19, 2023, will be used for seeding purposes.
- B. League Champions- Those teams which are league champions will be seeded at the top of each classification. Where a classification has more than one league champion, the rating system will determine each champion's seeding. This provision does not apply to sub-regionals.
- C. All league champions should be determined by Friday, May 19, 2023.

<u>GAME LOCATIONS:</u> All pigtail, first round and quarterfinal games will be played on the home field of the higher seeded team. Hosting teams who do not have lights will not be permitted to begin these rounds after 4:30pm.

PLEASE NOTE:

Each school is responsible to provide for their own trainer. The top seeded team will be the home team and occupy the first base dugout when at a neutral site regardless of their position in the bracket. Seeding is only recognized for sites on the first and second rounds of play. For the semifinal and final games, the sites are chosen by the District Committee and consideration is given for TV coverage in selecting the sites.

PREGAME SCHEDULE:

- 50 minutes prior to start Home team BP (cage)
- 40 minutes prior to start Visiting team BP (cage)
- 30 minutes prior to start Home team infield/outfield
- 20 minutes prior to start Visiting team infield/outfield
- 10 minutes prior to start Meeting at home plate
- 5 minutes prior to start Lineups, National Anthem
